Who are the Churchill Partners?

Churchill Partners was founded in 1993 when the new ICRF Oncology Unit was being built at the Churchill Hospital. The idea was to capitalise on the physical presence of the clinical units to encourage fundraising where it could be seen that ICRF was supporting patients and not just laboratory research.

Over the years we have worked successfully as a small committee organising relatively low-key events such as an annual Oxford Guided Walk and Cream Tea, Supermarket Collections, Carol Singing and production of our own Christmas Cards, knowing that we can call on the support of many people throughout Oxfordshire for assistance. The Christmas Cards alone raise well over £4,000 per annum.

There are also those who run their own fundraising events and like to donate the proceeds to us, knowing that all the money raised through us goes to support the work of Cancer Research UK in Oxford. This is principally for the care and treatment of patients in the Churchill Hospital, including clinical research. In addition we receive In Memoriam and other donations for the same reason.

Since our formation, we have raised over £860,000. We are always looking for innovative ways to raise money for a cause we consider so important.
